This is a choral project based on the reproduction of women's portraits of mixed ages and ethnicities where I will print the word "stop" in different languages . For the portraits I use a photographic technique known as Gum Diazo Printing that I learnt from Graciela Olio, Paulina Rucco and Sol Carta in Argentina.

In Spanish "to develop a photo from a negative " is translated by using the verb " to reveal" and I love " revealing" the faces of women saying STOP to the violence against women.



I invite you to collaborate with this project.

### How?

You have to take a picture of yourself. It may be a selfie, but it is important:

- that you have frontal light, avoiding if you can areas with shadows.
- If you have dark hair, try to have a light background and vice versa.
- Try to focus on the message we want to convey when you take the photo ( don't smile)
- Try to send it in the best definition you can. The photo will be reproduced in cm 25 x cm 25 at a maximum of 300 dpi.

But if you don't understand what we are speaking about, send the photo and we can try to fix it.
